# Retrospective:

## What went well

- Start 10k at 7:30 instead of 7:15 alleviated some pressure on the restroom line
- Use formula 1 unit / 75 registrations. Had one more unit than 2022 (our numbers were down 100)
- Submit to Cary Special Events to obtain proper barricades instead of cones (Free!)
- Changed formula to registration cutoff + 20% + round up resulted in very few leftover tshirts
- Judy Liu did a great job handing out awards and getting pictures
- Cargo net enabled one trip to the convenience center instead of two for the garbage and bottles.
- Umstead Coalition near the finish got more attention
- Getting a second table from the shed to do both sets awards helped. Finished awards could dry overnight and I wasn't in a hurry to pack them. They weren't stuck together or damaged
- Addressed most of the serious problems from 2022

# What could be improved

- Submit Cary permit earlier
- Include instructions to bring a knife or scissors to cut the zip ties to water station instructions
- Location of WS1 portajohn needs to be in the parking area that is not across the street from Beals frontage.
- Portajohns need hand sanitizer
- The park had one cone at a washout near the power lines. Some runners thought this was the turnaround.
- Do not remove ANY barricades until the road is ready to open. When cars were able to drive around the large Type 3 "road closed" barricades, they did while we were still loading the truck.
- I was concerned about the noise level when the DJ first set up. Move the setup closer to the start but point the subwoofer away from the apartments.
- Communicate with Trek Holly Park to coordinate start times for their Sunday Dirt Church ride
- T-Shirt graphic did not look very good, not very much color contrast between the light grey that Progressive used and the tshirts which were lighter than in the proof.
- Bananas from Farmers Market were not very ripe. Need to purchase them earlier.
- Still experimenting with awards times. 10k around 8:45, HM around 9:45?
- Left over awards should be returned to the box stacked vertically instead of horizontally (do not stack on top of each other). When I went to find awards to mail, they were all waste
- Getting t-shirts to WS volunteers (WS1 picked theirs up Saturday)

## Other Ideas

- Have an awards volunteer to get pictures for people who leave before ceremonies
- Move Type 2 Barricades to intersection (Cary Events did not pick them up immediately)
- Print a big canvas with NCRC to cover the box truck for pictures (ThinkPG can do this cheaply)
