#### **DETAILS:**

- Novice Rider to never have won 1st place in that class.
- Showmanship (#7) will follow Aged Geldings (#4). Then Leadline Equitation (#5) will follow Showmanship (#7), Leadline Trail (#6) will follow Leadline Equitation (#5). All other classes will run in order.
- Trail classes will be in order.
- Leadline High Point will be announced immediately following Leadline Trail class.
- Equitation classes judge the rider and Pleasure classes judge the horse.
- Adult Leadline is led by a youth, Ages 8 12.

#### **STALL FEES:**

- Stalls will be available for Friday and Saturday evenings, \$5 per stall night per horse.
- Participants must clean and bring own bedding.
- Reserve stalls during registration.

# **RANCH TRAIL CHALLENGE:**

- Class will consist of 12 obstacles, each worth 10 points, with 2 individual judges, each scoring 6
  of the obstacles.
- After 3 refusals, rider will move on to next obstacle, receiving 0 points on that maneuver, but will <u>not</u> disqualify rider from the class.
- Course will be posted early; a walk through for riders will be held before the start of all trail classes.
- Horses are not allowed on the course before judging.
- Riders may ask judge for direction while on course, or may have outside prompt read to them.
- Copies of the course will be available.
- Safety is number one! This course will be challenging but not scary. We want everyone, regardless of age or riding level to have fun!
- Leadline and 10 and under trail obstacles will be age appropriate.
- Two hands may be used on reins to maneuver an obstacle.
