BOWLING RULES

Tournament

- The tournament is sanctioned by United States Bowling Congress (USBC).
- The tournament is open to all bowlers.
- USBC membership cards are required and are available for purchase onsite.
- All bowlers will use their average from the 2024-2025, with a minimum of 21 games. Bowlers without the above average may use their final 2023-2024 average, with a minimum of 21 games. If they do not have either average, they will bowl in the Open division.

Handicap

- All Open division will bowl scratch with no handicap.
- All other divisions will receive handicap; handicap will be 100% of the difference between bowler's average and 220.

Awards

- All divisions will bowl 3 games.
- Top 3 scores in each division will receive medals.
- Medals will be awarded at the conclusion of each division session.

Team Format Only

- All team members need to register.
- All team divisions will bowl 3 games, their total score bowled plus their handicap will equal their total score.
- Team captains please list Team Name, all team members in bowling order on your entry form and indicate the time you would like to bowl.
- Team Divisions
 - Adult Divisions
 - 4 members: male, female, or mixed teams competing in 3 divisions.
 - "A Division" – total team average of 700+.
 - "B Division" – total team average of 699 & under.
 - "Open Division" – no team average limit.
 - Youth Division
 - 4 members: male, female, or mixed teams competing in 1 division.

(Commissioner reserves the right to combine or expand divisions based on registrations.)
