### **Putting Challenge:**

- Introduction: The Putting Challenge gauges participants' accuracy and precision across various distances.
- Event Details: Two stations are set up for the Putting Challenge, allowing participants to take turns attempting 30 putts. Each station features distances of 20, 25, 30, 35, and 40 feet. An additional set of five putts from 50 feet is included. Participants will throw one at a time at each station.
- Scoring System: Successful putts, defined by the PDGA, earn 2 points each. A maximum of 100 points can be achieved (2 points per 25 putts and 10 points per 5 putts from 50 feet).

### **Approach Challenge:**

- Introduction: The Approach Challenge tests participants' throwing accuracy and decision-making at various distances.
- Event Details: Five baskets are arranged for the Approach Challenge. Participants move progressively from 100 to 350 feet, attempting 20 throws. Flag poles 25 feet off the teeing area direct throws to the right, center, left, and one player's choice.
- Scoring System: Points are awarded based on throws landing within three circles: 5-meter (5 points), 10-meter (3 points), and 15-meter (1 point). A maximum of 100 points can be earned.

### **Driving Challenge:**

- Introduction: The Driving Challenge challenges participants to showcase power and accuracy within a 25-foot-wide fairway.
- Event Details: Participants attempt four throws, with the best two scored. BSSG flags line the field every 100 feet. Baskets are positioned at 300 and 500 feet, with distance markings up to 600 feet.
- Scoring System: Points are deducted for feet outside the fairway. Maximum score is 100, with placements affecting scoring based on the number of participants in the division.

### **Speed Gun Challenge:**

- Introduction: The Speed Gun Challenge measures participants' throwing speed with precision.
- Event Details: Participants make five throws, and a radar speed gun measures each throw's speed.
- Scoring System: Points are awarded based on the combined total speed of the two fastest throws, with a maximum of 100 points.
