<u>Precision Air Rifle</u> OR <u>Sporter Air Rifle</u>: Saturday, Late a.m. • Saturday, p.m. • Sunday a.m. (Indicate first and second choice of shooting time on registration).

40 shots standing; 3 P is 30 shots 3 position, 33 feet metallic sights. NRA rules. <u>Special Info:</u> Air rifle competitors must choose between sporter rifle and precision rifle, competitors cannot enter both. Competitors will be informed of relay assignments one week prior to match.

Sporter Air Rifle Prone: Saturday a.m.

40 shots, Prone Match. NRA Rules: 33 ft, metallic sights, Junior Shooters only.

<u>Air Pistol:</u> Saturday, Late a.m. • Saturday p.m. • Sunday a.m. (Indicate first and second choice of shooting time on registration)

40 shots, 33 feet, metallic sights. NRA/Int'l rules.

BB Gun: Saturday. 8:00 a.m. First Relay • 9:30 a.m. Second Relay.

40 shots, 4 position, metallic sights. NRA rules no test targets.

<u>High Power Rifle:</u> Sunday • 8:00 a.m.

50 shots with sighting shots, 600 yd. reduced to 300 yd. NRA rules. • Juniors and new shooters need not list classifications. Vintage rifle will be shot as a classification, not as a separate event (you cannot shoot both standard high power and vintage).

F-Class High Power Rifle: Saturday • 8:00 a.m.

60 shots, 3x20 with sighting shots, F-Class 300 yard targets, NRA rules.
