Facility:

City of Bryan staff, along with T.A.A.F. officials and volunteers, will be available to help direct spectators around the exterior of the facility and ensure the pool deck remains clear for athletes and authorized personnel. We kindly ask all spectators to treat one another and event staff with respect throughout the event.

Spectator seating will be all on one-side of the facility in the grandstands area which will be directly behind the coaches area.

Designated tent city area for tents and seating will be available outside the facility fence. Please bring your own lawn chairs and tents. Pop-up tents, canopies, and similar structures will be limited to the approved tent city area behind the grandstands.

For safety reasons, children must be supervised at all times and should refrain from running or horseplay around the venue.

Facility restrooms are reserved exclusively for T.A.A.F. officials, coaches, and athletes who have completed the T.A.A.F. background check process. Restrooms for spectators will be available in two

locations: the main parking lot of the Bryan Aquatic Center and the designated tent area directly behind the grandstands.

Concessions:

A variety of local food trucks and vendors will be on-site in the main Bryan Aquatic Center parking lot during each session, offering a range of food and beverage options for athletes, families, and spectators to enjoy.

- **JJ's Snow Cones** – A local favorite serving refreshing shaved ice treats.
- **Something Different** – Specialty lemonade, hot dogs, nachos, and more.
- **A&Y Texas Kitchen** – Popular local vendor featuring both breakfast and lunch/dinner options.
- **Big Dawg BBQ** – Crowd favorite offering authentic Texas-style barbecue.
- **Papa John's Pizza** – Classic pizza options from a national chain.

Food/Drink Inside Facility:

While food trucks will be available on-site during the event, spectators are welcome to bring outside food and beverages into the facility. Coolers are permitted; however, **glass containers and alcohol are strictly prohibited**. Facility staff reserves the right to inspect all coolers upon entry.

In addition, there are several fast-food and dining options conveniently located near the Bryan Aquatic Center, including:

Walmart is also located nearby and is within walking distance of the facility.

Parking:

Parking directly in front of the pool will be **restricted** and reserved for emergency services, concessions, vendors, meet operations, ticket sales, and pedestrian access to and from the venue.

Spectator parking will be available in the large parking lot adjacent to the Bryan Aquatic Center. Signage and staff will be on-site to help direct traffic and ensure a smooth arrival experience.

Pool Deck:

Access to the pool deck is strictly limited to authorized personnel only. **Coaches, parents, and spectators are not permitted** behind the starting blocks, in the timer/officials' area, or within the heating/event area at any time.

Only City of Bryan venue staff, T.A.A.F. officials, timers, and designated event personnel are allowed on the pool deck. Spectators found in unauthorized areas will be escorted from the facility.

We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining a safe and efficient competition environment.

Spectator Seating:

Temporary grandstand seating will be constructed on-site, providing a net capacity of approximately 1,200 spectators. **Tents, lawn chairs, and other personal seating are not permitted** inside the facility.

Seating is available on a **first-come, first-served** basis for each session. At the conclusion of every session, all spectators will be required to exit the facility and grandstand areas. This allows staff and T.A.A.F. officials to properly reset and prepare the venue for the next session.

Seat reservations are not allowed, and all personal belongings must be removed between sessions. Items left behind will be collected and placed in the lost and found.

Approved Tent Areas (Tent City) and Cooling Stations:

Designated tent areas will be located directly behind the Bryan Aquatic Center and the grandstands. A cooling tent will be available in this area for use by both spectators and athletes seeking relief from the heat.

Spectators attending multiple sessions are encouraged to bring their own pop-up tents for shade. Please note that **space and access to power in approved tent areas will be limited**, so plan accordingly.

For safety reasons, **gasoline and diesel-powered generators are not permitted** in the tent area.

Admissions:

Admission passes will be available for purchase at the Bryan Aquatic Center ticket booths beginning **Thursday, July 31st at 10:00 a.m.** Each session pass will be **color-coded** and must match the designated session for entry—please plan accordingly.

Spectator entrance will begin 90 minutes before each session. Entry and exit points are marked on the venue map included in this packet.

Accepted Payment Methods:

- Cash
- Credit/Debit (Visa and MasterCard only)

Admission Prices:

- **Per Session:** \$7.00 per person
- **All-Session Pass:** \$35.00 per person

Athlete & Coach Check-In

Athletes and coaches will enter through the designated Athlete/Coach Entrance shown on the venue map. Check-in will open **30 minutes prior to each session's scheduled warm-up time.**

Only coaches who have successfully completed the **T.A.A.F. background check process** will be issued a **pre-assigned coaches badge** granting access to the Coaches Area. They must be on the approved coaches list posted at www.taaf.com . Coaches without this badge will **not** be permitted in the coaches area. Coaches will need to show a valid ID to pick up a badge. **Each team will receive 2 passes for coaches.** All-Session wristbands will also be given to any other coach on the approved list posted on www.taaf.com but this wristband **will not** grant coaches access to the coaches area only the spectator area.
