DIVISIONS:

Backyard - intended for beginners and large events that have a lot of Intermediate players. This player has limited experience with the game and usually has very little control over where the bag is going. (PPR Range: < 6.39)

Competitive - intended for players who are good, but not quite ready for the Advanced level. For areas that have a lot of depth at the top end of players. This player fully understands game strategy but may struggle with consistency. At times this player looks like they can beat anyone, but then in a subsequent game or round can struggle. (PPR Range: 6.4 – 7.48)

Advanced - maximum points towards player rankings. There can certainly be top level players in the Advanced Skill Level who have not yet earned/accepted the ACL Pro Player Title. This player can execute sliding the bag and airmailing the bag as needed. Player fully understands game strategy and likely plays and practices on a regular basis. (PPR Range: > 7.49 & up)

PPR stands for Points Per Round which is a player's average points per round during game play.

TOURNAMENT PLAY: All players **must download SCOREHOLIO app** and create a player profile. You will need to have the app and your player profile QR code for the tournament. Tournament will consist of a qualifying pool play or round robin. Teams will be seeded, based on qualifier, into an elimination bracket. **Outside bags allowed; both teams must agree.**
Busting allowed.
